 - 2. ENGAGE your school and community sessions, surveys, census and academic data research, to develop a vision and strategy.
 - 3. UNDERSTAND the challenges and opportunities at the school, neighborhood and systems level.
 - 4. ANALYZE the results of the needs and assets map and visioning process, and identify priorities.
 - 5. CREATE a plan to address priorities,
 - 6. STAY CONNECTED to your broader school community.
 - 7. EVALUATE regularly.
 - 8. WORK TOGETHER to overcome challenges and barriers.
- Discussion Questions: What are ways you can carry out these steps? i.e. canvassing, surveying etc. More ideas on the hand out.

Part Two: Community Needs, Assets, and Vision Mapping

- Discussion Question: How do you find out the needs in the community you're partnered with? Hand Out Community Resource Assessment as a resource, but most importantly we have to rethink what it means to engage the community. How do we see Parents being engaged today?
